Being a predatory fish at the top of the food chain pike have long been regarded as vermin to be killed and removed. Regional Associations

PAC is organised into regional associations, usually centred around a town or area all over the UK and Ireland. There are around 50 regions, all run by experienced members and all members are welcome to attend. Regions hold regular monthly evening meetings throughout the pike season and invite guest speakers to entertain and inspire their members. Some regions even have their own website or blog too and hold regular events and fish-ins. The 'RA's' are the lifeblood of the club and all members (experienced or novice) are encouraged to take part. Who knows, one day you may well decide to run a region yourself!

Privileged Access Events

As a PAC member you will be eligible to attend any of the number of privileged access events held by the club every year across the length and breadth of the country. PAC strives to gain access to new events (often with exclusive pike fishing) each year. They are key club social events.

Annual Convention

The annual convention is the largest pike-related show in the country and attracts some of the biggest names in predator sports. Whether you want to get a bargain, chat to the country's leading pike anglers or just watch the expert talks and catch up with old friends, the convention is the place to be. **ALL** pike anglers are made welcome; both members and non-members.

Clothing and Products

Third Party Liability Cover

Pike angling carries risks no matter how careful you are you could find yourself the subject of legal action. Members are entitled to claim against the club's third party liability cover in the event of causing injury or loss to a third party whilst fishing in the UK; be it on a PAC event or individually. Members may claim up to £10m in any one year, even if there were multiple claims made against members we are fully covered should the unthinkable happen. Full terms and conditions of cover are available on request.

PAC operates one of the most highly regarded fishing websites on the internet. Members get free access to all areas of the site, including the members-only forum, where you can swap tips and advice with other members, and get the latest news on the club, or your local region.
